[GCBS Entrance Test \(GET\) Centre and Test Room Allocation, 25 April 2026](#)

In continuation of the earlier announcement, GCBS is pleased to announce the Test Centres and test room allocations for all the shortlisted candidates for the GCBS Entrance Test (GET) scheduled on **25 April 2026**. Please read the following information carefully to ensure a smooth and orderly conduct of the test.

Information for the Candidates

Kindly take note of the following information before you appear for your GET.

a. Technical Requirements:

1. You will be provided a desktop or a laptop computer connected to the Internet. You need to access the online Moodle portal, VLE, using the credentials provided at the Test centres.
2. You are required to produce your original national CID while entering the test rooms. **You WILL NOT be allowed to enter the test hall without producing your original national CID.**
3. You are allowed to carry a calculator, a pen and a pencil as there are simple mathematical equations to be solved, although the answers are going to be MCQ. A blank sheet of A4-sized paper will be provided for rough work. However, you are **NOT ALLOWED** to carry a mobile phone, smartwatch, or any other Personal Digital Assistant (PDA), or any notes or formulas, inside the test rooms.

b. Time Management:

1. You need to complete the test within **2 hours and 30 minutes**. However, should any technical errors persist, their time may be adjusted accordingly.
2. **Your reporting time to the test centres is at 9:00 a.m.** and the writing will start from 9:30 a.m. sharp, and the test will terminate automatically at exactly **12:00 p.m.**
3. If you arrive **after 30 minutes** of the test time, you will not be allowed to enter the test room.
4. Manage your time effectively during the test.
5. **REMEMBER!** If you want your application to be considered for all the **FOUR** Programmes under **Category A**, then you have to write the Personal Statements for all the four. Similarly, for **Category B**, you need to write the Personal Statement for all the **THREE** programmes. ***If you just write for one programme, your application will be considered only for that programme.*** You may write a **maximum of 250 words** for each Personal Statement.
6. The duration of the GET is inclusive of the number of Personal Statements that you may write.

7. The candidates are **NOT** allowed for restroom breaks; however, you may exit the exam hall at any time and will not be allowed back into the test rooms.

c. Honest and Integrity:

1. As prospective students of GCBS, you are must maintain academic honesty and integrity throughout the test. **DO NOT** engage in any form of cheating, plagiarism, or any unauthorised collaboration. You may lose your privilege should you disrespect the decorum.
2. You are **NOT ALLOWED** to take any other **unauthorised** materials in the test rooms other than those specified under section **a (1)**. Any other materials that may aid in answering the questions or help in gaining advantages over others shall be deemed as the **use of unfair means** and have candidacy revoked.
3. You are not allowed to access other unauthorised websites/browsers, notes, or other materials during the test. If found, **clause (2)** of this section shall be applied.

d. Follow Instructions:

1. **Carefully read and follow all the instructions** provided for the test, including how to navigate the test platform, respond to different question types, and seek assistance if necessary (only for technical support).
2. The College **shall not** be responsible should you fail to follow the instructions.
3. Have patience if the Internet is slow. Hastily clicking and refreshing may result in the loss of information.

e. Technical Support:

1. Contact the designated invigilator should you encounter any technical problems.
2. Technical problem will **NOT** be entertained as an excuse for the incompleteness of the test.

f. Absence from the Test:

1. If you do not show up at the test centre to which you have been allocated, your candidacy shall not be considered in GCBS.
2. Test Centre Managers/Invigilators shall note any absentees and submit the list to GCBS.
3. If you arrive 30 minutes after the test begins, you will **NOT** be allowed to take the test and will be considered absent.

2. Test duration: 2 hours and 30 minutes
3. Candidates **WILL NOT** be allowed into the test rooms after 10:00 a.m. (30 minutes after test commencement)
